Department is desirous to recruit a Social Safeguards Specialist for Punjab Rural Water and Sanitation Sector Improvement Project (PRWSSIP)

Key Responsibilities

- 1) Must be conversant with World Bank Safeguard policies obligations Indigenous Peoples OP/BP 4.10 & Involuntary Resettlement OP/BP 4.12 procedures and application and conversant with GoI and preferably Punjab government's social assessment regulations and procedures
- 2) Coordinate with World Bank Specialist for the field visits to review social safeguards compliance
- 3) Undertaking reviews and preparing reports on World Bank Policies on Involuntary Resettlement and Indigenous Peoples
- 4) Undertake frequent field visits to all Surface Water project sites to monitor the implementation of SMPs, RAPs and any other social safeguard measures required for the project;
- 5) Provide assistance in undertaking socially inclusive assessments, participatory planning, implementation, monitoring, social audit for achieving sustainability with an emphasis on poor and gender inclusion.
- 6) Undertake field assessments ensuring guidance and supervision of the implementation of project;
- 7) Ensure the effective integration of social safeguards and due diligence as defined in the ESMP (Environment & Social Management Plan) & ESIA while designing, implementation and monitoring of water supply & sanitation schemes as well as to take due cognizance of disclosure requirements.
- 8) Prepare TORs to guide contractors to prepare site specific social safeguards instruments required for mitigating social impacts of proposed projects prior to commencement of civil works;
- 9) Screening of DWSS sub-projects and advising requirement of specific management and action plans to mitigate adverse social impacts due to various project interventions
- 10) Ensure zero tolerance for sexual exploitation and abuse by project workers (including the contractors and implementing agency staff, facilitate HIV/AIDs orientation programme at construction sites, address any issue related to labour influx in consultation with Labour Officer of the project etc.
- 11) Identify the capacity building needs of DWSS staff especially with the IEC & CDS, NGOs and technical staff engaged in the project for achieving sustainability of the project and capacitate them through trainings.
- 12) Participate in reviews undertaken by DWSS and during world bank supervision mission

- 13) Review RAP/ARAP/s and other social documents prepared by consultants to ensure compliance with relevant safeguards policies of the World Bank and Punjab's specific policies on the same;
- 14) Under the guidance of the CSDO, should review, share all draft Resettlement Action Plans, Resettlement Policy Framework (if required to be revised or updated), to DWSS and World Bank for review and clearance and upon approval from the Bank, disclose the final document on DWSS website
- 15) Prepare and submit monthly monitoring reports on implementation status of SMPs, RAPs, redressal of grievances and any other social safeguard measures to be taken to address social issues to CSDO/DWSS, in addition, the Social Safeguards Specialist will also be required to prepare or contribute to the preparation of other social status and monitoring reports, as and when needed;
- 16) Perform any other duty assigned officially by DWSS.

- 1) Master's in Social Sciences or Sociology or Social Development or equivalent from a reputed University with minimum 55 percent marks.
- 2) Additional weightage will be given to higher degree holder in concerned subject.
- 3) Have 5 years relevant practical experience as a social safeguard specialist especially in social assessment studies and management, rural poverty and development, gender analysis, community mobilization sustainable development, social protection, project implementation and capacity building of various stakeholders.
- 4) Must be familiar with World Bank Safeguard policies, procedures and application and conversant with GoI and preferably Punjab government's social assessment regulations and procedures
